An OLT optical port module is a hardware component that enables an optical line terminal (OLT) to transmit and receive fiber optic signals to and from optical network units (ONUs) or terminals (ONTs). Function of OLT Optical Port Modules OLT optical port modules serve as the interface between the OLT and the passive optical network (PON). They perform electro-optical conversion, allowing the OLT to send downstream data to subscribers and receive upstream data from ONUs/ONTs. Each module typically supports one or more PON ports, which can connect to multiple end users depending on the split ratio of the network (e.g., 1:32, 1:64, or up to 1:128 for XGS-PON). These modules are often implemented as SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or line cards, which can be inserted into the OLT chassis. They are designed to handle specific wavelengths for transmission (Tx) and reception (Rx), ensuring proper communication with the connected ONUs. Not all OLTs use SFP modules, but when they do, the module must be compatible with the OLT to swap Tx and Rx wavelengths correctly.
