

Operation of 3m optical cable splice package

Insert the first fiber: Push the cleaved fiber into the splice until resistance is felt. The fiber should be straight or have a slight bow (up to 3 mm), with no bare glass visible outside the splice. Insert the second fiber: Repeat the process for the second fiber, ensuring proper alignment and contact within the splice. Securing and Organizing Actuate the splice: Once both fibers are inserted, the Fibrlok mechanism secures the fibers permanently, providing low-loss optical performance. Label and store: Place the completed splice into a Fibrlok 2523 splice organizer tray or 2524 splice tray for protection and organization. These trays can accommodate up to 48 fibers and fit into various closures, including 3M 2177, 2178, or 2190 closures. Best Practices Ensure the splicing area is clean, dry, and well-lit to improve efficiency and reduce contamination. Periodically check cleave lengths duri...
