Lay a 10 cm layer of fine sand at the bottom to cushion the conduit and prevent damage from sharp stones. Clear the duct with a rod and pre-install a pulling rope to facilitate cable installation. Cable Pulling Pulling the fiber optic cable is a critical stage. Use a tension controller to monitor pulling force and ensure it does not exceed the cable's rated tensile strength. Maintain a pulling speed of ≤ 15 m/min and use swivel connectors and guiding pulleys when navigating corners to prevent torque and bending stress. Avoid kinking the cable, as this can damage the fibers and reduce signal quality.
