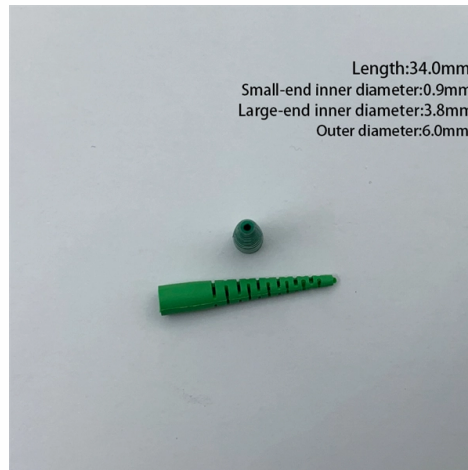

For coastal, chemical, or high-pressure wash environments, consider NEMA 4X or IP66/67 for corrosion resistance and water jet protection. Materials can include powder-coated carbon steel, aluminum, stainless steel, or fiberglass, chosen based on environmental exposure and durability requirements. Electrical Components and Safety Inside the distribution box, include bus bars, circuit breakers, fuses, and a main disconnect as required by NEC Article 312. Ensure separate ground and neutral bars and proper earthing to prevent electrical hazards. Use DIN rails and cable entry points for neat wiring and future maintenance.
