

Palau sells power fiber optic cables

Palau owns and operates submarine fiber optic cables through state-owned and national corporations, providing wholesale and business internet services rather than retail cable sales. This includes backup connectivity, multi-line phone systems, and high-speed internet for commercial clients.

International Support and Development The development of Palau's fiber optic network has been supported by international partners, including the Asian Development Bank, Australia, Japan, and the United States, through loans and grants to expand digital connectivity. These projects aim to enhance access to e-health, e-education, and e-governance services, integrating Palau into the global internet infrastructure.
