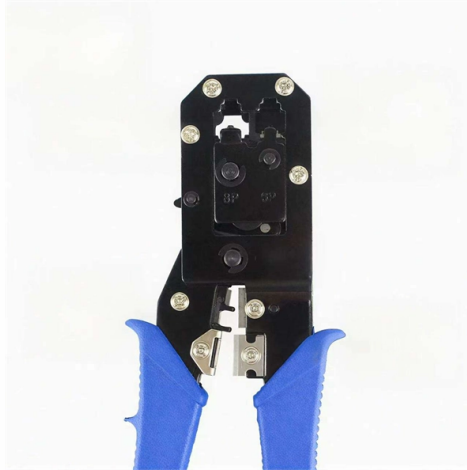


Patch Cords and Fiber Optic Connectors

Common Connector Types

- LC (Lucent Connector):** Small form factor with a 1.25mm ferrule, widely used in modern data centers for high-density applications. It uses a push-pull latch mechanism for secure and easy deployment.
- SC (Subscriber Connector):** Features a 2.5mm ferrule with a push-pull snap-in design, common in legacy enterprise networks, PON/GPON systems, and industrial applications.
- FC (Ferrule Connector):** Uses a screw-on thread mechanism, ideal for high-vibration environments, often found in older single-mode networks.
- MPO/MTP (Multi-Fiber Push-On / Multi-Fiber Termination Push-On):** Multi-fiber connectors housing 8, 12, 16, 24, or 32 fibers in a single ferrule, essential for high-density parallel optics like 40G, 100G, and 400G Ethernet.
- Emerging Connectors (MDC/CS):** Designed for ultra-high-density 400G/800G deployments, increasingly used in modern data centers.

Assembly Styles

- Simplex:** Single connector on one fiber, used for point-to-point connections.
- Duplex:** Two connectors side by side, often called “zip cord,” used for bidirectional communication or paired fiber links.

Polish Types

- PC (Physical Contact):** Slightly spherical end-face, return loss around -40dB .
- UPC (Ultra Physical Contact):** Refined polish for better surface finish, return loss around -55dB , common in digital applications.
- APC (Angled Physical Contact):** Angled end-face to minimize back reflection, used in high-precision or analog systems.

Applications

- Single-mode fibers:** Long-distance transmission, telecom, and enterprise backbones.
- Multimode fibers:** Short-distance connections within data centers and LANs.
- High-density environments:** LC duplex and MPO/MTP connectors dominate due to space efficiency and scalability.
