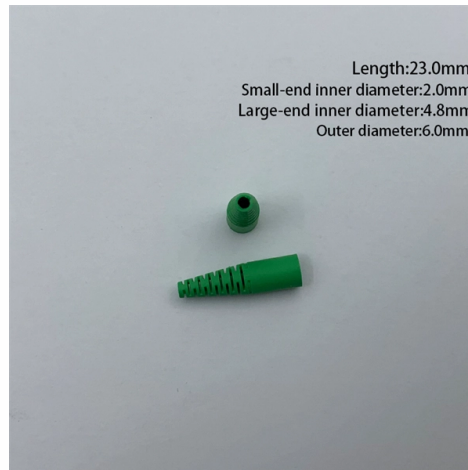


Power off switch of building distribution box
