Check Switch Specifications: Verify whether your fiber switch supports PoE or requires an external power supply. Some high-speed or multi-port switches may have specific power modules.

Use Compatible Power Modules: For powered fiber systems, ensure the extenders or modules match the switch's voltage and power class. Some systems allow multiple devices to be powered from a single source.

Safety and Cabling: Follow manufacturer guidelines for grounding, cable routing, and maximum power limits to prevent overheating or electrical hazards.

Media Converters: If using fiber media converters to bridge copper and fiber networks, ensure the converter is powered either via PoE or a dedicated adapter.
