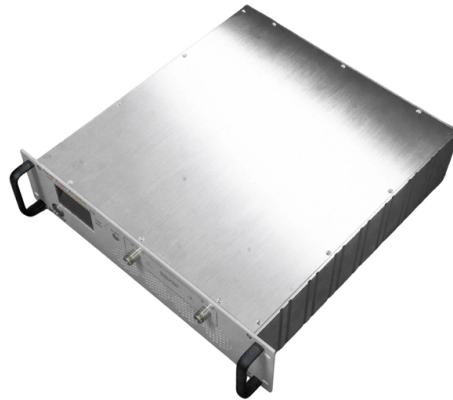


Powering on the head unit equipment

Power Requirements

Unit powers on but no sound: Verify speaker connections and impedance compatibility. Most head units require a minimum 4-ohm load.

Power button unresponsive: Some units allow powering on via the accessory wire or remote wire; consult the manual.
