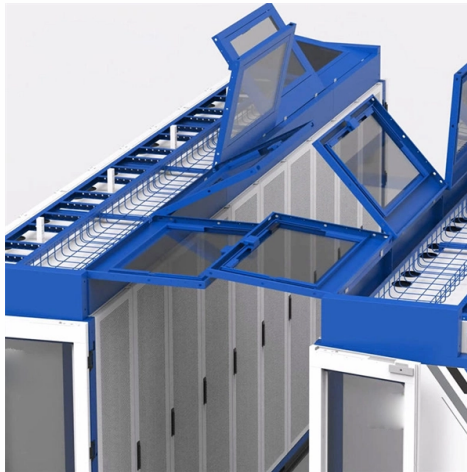


Price of Fiber Optic Communication Deployment Nodes



AI Overview

The cost of deploying fiber optic nodes typically ranges from \$5 to \$27 per foot, with labor accounting for 60–80% of total costs depending on deployment type and location. Cost Overview Fiber optic deployment costs vary significantly based on installation method, geography, and project scale. According to the Fiber Broadband Association and Cartesian 2024 study, typical costs are:

Underground deployments: \$10–\$27 per foot, with median labor costs around \$13/foot. Trenching is the most expensive method at \$26.50/foot, while plowing is cheaper at \$14.50/foot.

Aerial deployments: \$5–\$14 per foot, with median labor costs of \$4/foot for firms using their own poles and \$7/foot when renting poles. Strand and Lash cabling methods cost approximately \$6.75/foot and \$6.55/foot, respectively. Labor is the largest cost component, contributing roughly 73% of underground build costs and 67% of aerial build costs. Materials, equipment, and permitting add the remaining share.

Factors Affecting Costs

Deployment Type: Underground builds are more expensive due to trenching, conduit, and concrete work, while aerial builds are faster and cheaper if existing poles are available.

Geography and Terrain: Urban areas may have higher permitting and labor costs, while rural areas may require longer runs, increasing material and labor expenses.

Fiber Type and Node Complexity: Single-mode vs multimode fiber, strand count, and protective enclosures influence costs. Higher strand counts increase bandwidth but also raise material costs.

Labor Source: Outsourced labor is typically twice as expensive as internal crews.

Permitting and Regulatory Delays: Longer permit acquisition can increase project timelines and costs.
