Installation Environment: Indoor distribution boxes are installed in dry, accessible areas with proper ventilation, usually at a height of 1–1.8 meters for easy operation and maintenance. Outdoor boxes must withstand weather exposure, UV radiation, and potential chemical or dust hazards, necessitating higher IP ratings and robust materials.

Standards Compliance: Distribution boxes should comply with international and local standards such as IEC 60364, IEC 61439, BS 7671, or NEC. These standards specify minimum protection levels, accessibility, clearance, and installation requirements to ensure safety and reliability.

Surge Protection: For buildings prone to lightning or transient overvoltages, surge protection devices (SPDs) can be integrated into the distribution box. Level 1 SPDs protect against direct lightning strikes, Level 2 SPDs protect sensi...
