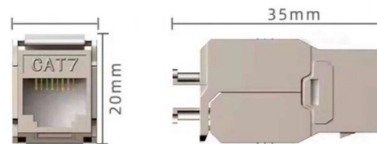

Ladder Cable Trays Ladder trays are open, rung-based structures that allow excellent ventilation and heat dissipation, making them suitable for high-heat environments and heavy-duty power cables. They are widely used in industrial and utility-scale installations. While they support high cable loads, their linear, two-dimensional design limits vertical containment, making them less optimal for extremely dense cabling compared to basket or hybrid trays.

Perforated Cable Trays Perforated trays feature a ventilated base for moderate-weight cables and structured cabling systems. They provide good airflow and cable support, and their enclosed design protects sensitive data and communication cables. While suitable for medium-density applications, they are less effective than basket or hybrid trays for maximum cable density.
