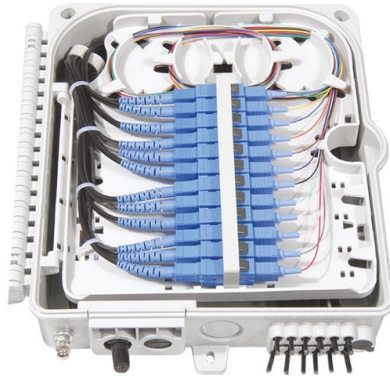


Regarding the installation of fiber optic cables on the roof

Securing the Cable Use cable clips, trays, or conduit to fasten the fiber along the roof surface, avoiding sharp bends or tension that could damage the fibers. Maintain a minimum bend radius as specified by the cable manufacturer to prevent signal degradation. For long roof runs, consider supporting the cable with Aramid yarn-reinforced conduits to reduce stress and protect against environmental damage.

Safety and Maintenance Wear protective gear such as gloves and safety glasses when handling fiber optic cables. Avoid stepping on cables or placing heavy objects on them. Inspect the installation periodically for loose fasteners, water ingress, or ph...
