

Replacing the router in a fiber optic network

Step 3: Connect the Router Disconnect the existing router from the ONT. Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT to the WAN port of your new router. Power on the router and wait for it to initialize.

Step 4: Configure Router Settings Access the router's admin panel via its IP address in a web browser. Enter your ISP-provided credentials if required (VLAN ID, PPPoE username/password). Configure Wi-Fi SSID, password, and security settings (WPA3 recommended). Set up advanced features like Quality of Service (QoS), guest networks, or parental controls if desired.

Step 5: Test and Optimize Verify that all devices can connect to the new router and access the internet. Run a speed test to ensure the router supports your fiber plan's full speed. Adjust router placement to minimize dead zones and interference, ideally near the center of your home and away from metal or concrete structures.
