

Requirements for binding pigtails

Definition and Purpose A pigtail is a short length of insulated wire, typically 6–8 inches, used to connect multiple circuit conductors to a single device terminal or to consolidate several wires together within a junction box or device enclosure. Pigtails prevent overloading device terminals, maintain circuit continuity if a device is removed, and simplify future troubleshooting or replacement.

Materials and Conductor Selection Use a conductor matching the gauge and type of the existing circuit wiring. For grounding pigtails, use green or bare copper conductors; for other circuits, match insulation type and voltage rating. Ensure all materials, including solder, flux, and connectors, are suitable for the conductor type and will not degrade the connection over time.

Connection Methods

- Mechanical twist and wire nuts:** Align stripped ends of the pigtail and circuit wires, twist together, and secure with a properly sized wire nut until no bare copper is exposed.
- Screw terminals:** Bend the pigtail into a “shepherd's hook” around the terminal screw in the tightening direction to ensure a low-resistance connection.
- Pressure connectors or lever nuts:** Acceptable alternatives for secure, code-compliant connections.

NEC Compliance

- Grounding pigtails:** NEC 250.148(B) requires that grounding conductors be connected so that removing a device does not interrupt grounding continuity.
- Splices:** NEC 300.13 mandates that splices maintain continuity without relying solely on device terminals.
- Box fill considerations:** Equipment grounding conductors count toward box fill allowances, but short bonding pigtails entirely within the same box may not add additional allowance.

Installation Best Practices

- Leave a service loop of extra wire (about 6 inches) for future modifications.
- Ensure mechanical and electrical security before soldering, if solder is used.
- Use UL-listed connectors and verify temperature...
