The blue color can also refer to the fiber optic connector itself. Blue fiber ends are commonly used for single-mode fibers with PC (Physical Contact) or UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) polish.

PC Polish: Slightly curved end-face reduces air gaps, minimizing back reflections and signal loss.

UPC Polish: More refined than PC, providing lower back reflection and higher return loss, suitable for high-speed data networks.

Contrast with Green Ends: Green fiber ends indicate APC (Angled Physical Contact) polish, which is used for systems requiring even lower back reflection.

Troubleshooting Tips

If the blue light blinks slowly for more than 15-20 minutes, it may indicate a connection issue. Ensure the fiber cable is securely connected and the router is powered on. Consult your router's manual for model-specific LED meanings, as manufacturers may vary slightly.
