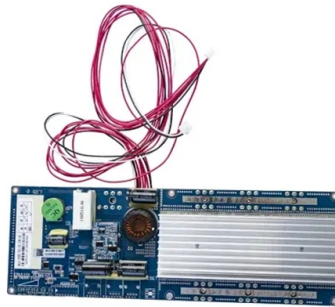


Routine maintenance of optical cable lines

Key tests for fiber characterization include Optical Return Loss (ORL), Insertion Loss, Polarization Mode Dispersion (PMD), and Chromatic Dispersion (CD), . Environmental Control Environmental factors significantly affect fiber performance. Maintain temperature between 18-27°C and relative humidity of 40-60% to prevent micro-bending losses . Use high-efficiency air filters and replace them regularly to reduce dust accumulation. In data centers, ensure proper airflow and dust removal in cold aisles to protect equipment and cabling . Physical Protection and Handling Avoid kinks, twists, or knots when coiling cables, and provide strain relief to prevent mechanical stress . Protect fibers in conduits to prevent micro-bending and pressure points. Regularly inspect overhead and underground cables, repairing hooks, chambers, and ventilation systems to pre...
