4. **Align and Insert the Connector** Hold the SC-P connector by its body, not the fiber. Align the connector with the device port. SC connectors use a push-pull mechanism; gently push the connector straight into the port until it clicks or seats firmly. Avoid forcing it, as misalignment can damage the fiber or port.
5. **Secure the Connection** Ensure the connector is fully seated and stable. If using a patch panel, insert the SC-P connector into the corresponding port and verify that the duplex orientation (Tx/Rx) matches the network configuration.
6. **Test the Connection** After connecting, test the link using an optical power meter or network tester to confirm signal integrity. This step ensures the connection is functioning correctly and helps identify any issues early.
