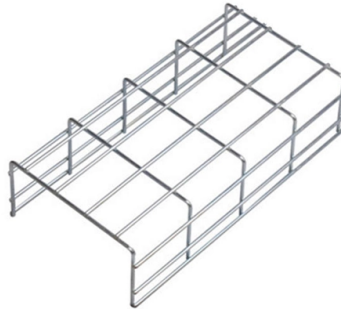


ST Interface to Optical Module
