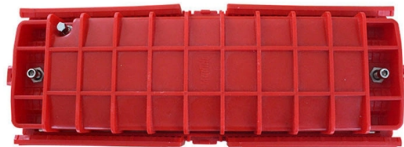

Hold-Down Clamps: Secure covers to the tray base, preventing accidental displacement and ensuring a continuous protective surface.
