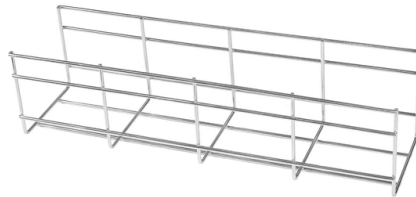

Connector Type: LC, SC, ST, etc., depending on your existing infrastructure.
