Be sure that the power distribution box has sufficient power provided to it. Long cable runs can result in a voltage drop, which can be solved by using a heavy gauge wire. In order to comply with these requirements there is certain information that must be known, such as the value of short-circuit current. A short circuit is an unintended path of low impedance between two or more conductors, allowing an abnormal flow of electricity.
