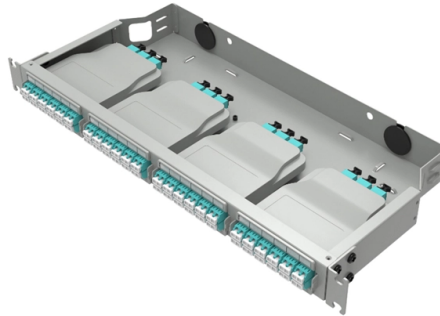


Sierra Leone Fiber Optic Loop

The Ministry of Information and Communication say the project is part of government's effort to further digitize the country.
