

Specifications and Dimensions of Cable Trays and Supports

Width and Depth: Cable trays are available in widths from 50 mm to 600 mm and depths from 25 mm to 150 mm, depending on cable fill requirements and tray type (ladder, ventilated, solid-bottom, or channel).

Length: Standard tray sections are typically 3 meters (10 feet) long, with shorter sections available for bends or transitions.

Rung Spacing: For ladder-type trays, rung spacing is generally 150-230 mm (6-9 inches) to provide adequate support and prevent cable sag.

Material Thickness: Steel trays usually have a thickness of 1.2-2.0 mm, while aluminum trays range from 1.5-2.5 mm, ensuring structural integrity under load.

Load Ratings and Support Spans

Load Class: Cable trays are classified by load-carrying capacity, which determines the maximum allowable span between supports. Light-duty trays may span 1.5-2 meters, medium-duty 2-3 meters, and heavy-duty trays up to 3.5 meters.

Support Spacing: Supports should be installed at intervals recommended by the manufacturer, typically every 1.5-3 meters, depending on tray type, material, and load.

Installation Guidelines

Supports must be securely anchored to walls, ceilings, or floors, and aligned to maintain tray level and straight runs.
