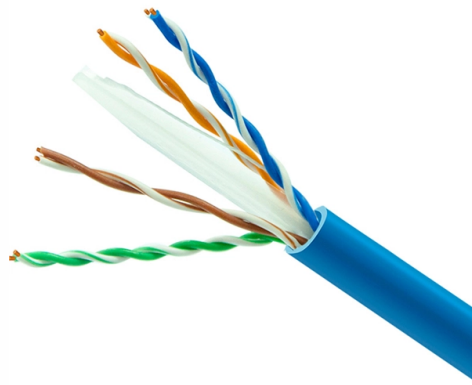

Future Expansion Consider potential future load increases. It is recommended to select a distribution box with additional capacity to accommodate new circuits or higher loads without replacing the entire panel ().

Protection Devices: Include fuses, circuit breakers, and residual current devices (RCDs) to prevent overloads, short circuits, and electric shocks ().

Voltage Regulation: Ensure voltage variations at consumer terminals remain within permissible limits (typically $\pm 6\%$ of rated voltage) to protect appliances and maintain efficiency ().

Proper Wiring: Use correct wire gauge, secure grounding, and neat cable management to handle the expected load safely ().
