FC (Ferrule Connector): Threaded coupling for high-vibration environments, offering precise alignment and low signal loss, often used in factories, railways, or aviation. E2000: Features automatic locking flap, push-pull mechanism, and optimized ferrule geometry, compliant with IEC 61754-7 standards.
