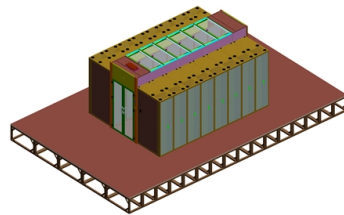


Steps for making jumper wires for a distribution box
