

Substation Cable Tray Installation

Marking and Layout: Use chalk lines, plumb bobs, and measuring tapes to mark tray routes, support positions, and bolt locations.

Support Installation: Install wall-mounted brackets or floor stands at 1.5–2 meter intervals, with additional supports within 600 mm of corners or T-junctions. Ensure supports are level and aligned.

Tray Assembly: Assemble trays according to manufacturer specifications, maintaining proper bend radius for cables and ensuring sections are securely fastened.

Expansion Gaps: Include 30–40 meter expansion gaps to accommodate thermal expansion and contraction of metal trays.

Cable Separation: Maintain at least 300 mm vertical separation between power and signal trays, or use solid dividers to prevent electromagnetic interference.

Inspection: Check alignment, leveling, and secure fastening of all trays and supports before cable installation.
