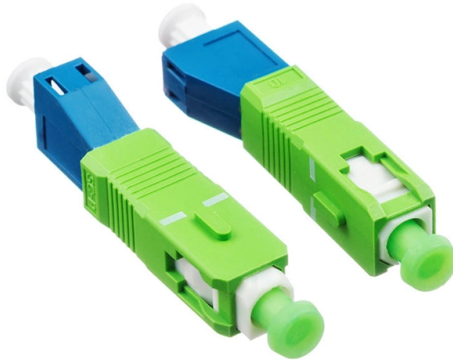


Tanzania Customs Costs SD-WAN Equipment NRZ

Importing SD-WAN equipment into Tanzania involves paying ad valorem import duty, VAT, and the Railway Development Levy, along with compliance documentation such as the PVoC and Certificate of Conformity. Import Duties and Taxes

Ad Valorem Import Duty: Calculated on the Cost, Insurance, and Freight (CIF) value of the SD-WAN equipment. For capital goods like networking equipment, the duty rate is typically 0% to 10% under the East African Community Common External Tariff, depending on classification.

Value Added Tax (VAT): A standard 18% VAT is applied on the CIF value plus import duty.

Railway Development Levy (RDL): A 1.5% levy on the CIF value of imported goods, aimed at funding infrastructure projects.

Excise Duty: Generally not applicable to standard SD-WAN equipment unless the devices are classified under luxury or telecommunications-specific excisable categories, which is uncommon.

Other Fees: Port and airport charges may apply depending on the entry point (Dar es Salaam Port, Julius Nyerere International Airport, or Kilimanjaro International Airport).

Required Documentation To clear SD-WAN equipment through Tanzanian customs, the following documents are typically required:

- Import Declaration Form (IDF) lodged with the Tanzania Revenue Authority prior to arrival.
- Pre-Shipment Verification of Conformity (PVoC) Certificate from an authorized agent to verify standards compliance.
- Certificate of Conformity (CoC) issued by the Tanzania Bureau of Standards.
- Commercial Invoice detailing the CIF value.
- Bill of Lading or Airway Bill.
- Packing List.
- Certificate of Origin to confirm the country of manufacture.

Clearance Process Engage a Clearing and Forwarding Agent: Submit all documents at least 7 days before arrival of the shipment.

Customs Declaration: The agent lodges the documents in the Tanzania Customs Integrated System for both Mainland and Zanzi...
