Grounding Components and Connections

Grounding Bus (PE Bus): The distribution box should have a dedicated grounding bus connected directly to the main power ground or building grounding system. All internal components that require grounding must be connected to this bus using copper wires or flexible braided conductors.

Metal Enclosure Bonding: The metal casing of the box must be bonded to the PE bus. This can be done using a box grounding bolt or factory-preset studs, ensuring low contact resistance. For stainless steel enclosures, flexible copper braided tape is recommended for moving parts like doors to maintain consistent grounding.

Conduit and Cable Grounding: Metal conduits connected to the box should also be electrically bonded to the enclosure. This can be achieved by welding or using conductive connectors to maintain equipotential bonding.

Wire Sizing and Resistance Requirements

In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is standard, while other markets may require 6 mm². The total ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 ohm to ensure effective fault current dissipation. For longer tool cables or multiple spindles, additional ground wires may be required to maintain low resistance, calculated using parallel resistance formulas to ensure the total remains below acceptable limits.
