

There are several ways to connect optical cables and fiber distribution boxes

For raw fibers: Strip the fiber, attach a protection connector, and perform a fusion splice with a pigtail before connecting to the adapter panel. Maintain proper bend radius to avoid signal loss or fiber breakage.

Step 4: Organize and Label Route branch fibers neatly along the designated paths inside the box, using movable cable ties or clips to secure them. Label each port and fiber for easy identification and future maintenance. Manage excess patch cords with Velcro straps or cable organizers to maintain a tidy setup.
