Cable Clamps and Bundling: Individual cables or bundles should be secured with cable clamps to prevent movement and mechanical stress. Multi-layer routing is possible using cable management trays, which allow separation of power, control, and communication cables.

Material and Corrosion Considerations

Materials: Steel, stainless steel, or GRP (glass-reinforced polyester) are commonly used for tunnel cable trays.

Surface Protection: Galvanization, epoxy coatings, or corrosion-resistant composites are essential to withstand tunnel humidity and chemical exposure.

Ventilation: Mesh trays improve airflow around cables, reducing heat buildup and prolonging cable life.

Load Capacity and Spacing

Maximum load per hanger typically ranges from 318 kg to 340 kg, with support spacing up to 3.6 meters depending on tray type and tunnel conditions. Proper load distribution prevents sagging and ensu...
