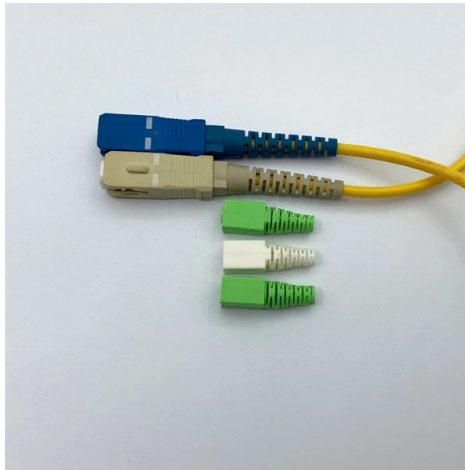


Tunnel power distribution box wiring method

Tunnel power distribution boxes are wired to provide 400V and 110V supplies with circuit protection, RCDs, and interlocked sockets for safe, extendable tunnel power distribution. Overview Tunnel distribution boxes (also called Tunnel Distribution & Lighting Boxes) are designed to supply power safely in harsh tunnel environments, providing both 400V for heavy machinery and 110V for lighting and small tools. They are typically housed in robust, IP55 or steel enclosures to protect against dust, water, and mechanical damage. Wiring Components Main Feed: Power enters the box via a main cable, often from a single source or step-up transformer (up to 3300V for long tunnels) and is stepped down to 400V/230V and 110V as needed. Transformers: Dual-output transformers can supply 400V for machinery and 110V for lighting and small tools. Step-down transformers are installed at intervals to maintain voltage levels along the tunnel. Sockets: Industrial socket outlets conforming to BS EN 60309 are used, with ratings of 16A, 32A, 63A, and 125A. Higher current sockets (up to 630A) feed specialist plant. Circuit Protection: Each socket is individually protected by MCBs or MCCBs and 30 mA RCDs. High-current sockets include pilot pins for Earth Continuity Monitoring, ensuring portable equipment is earthed and preventing plug insertion/removal under load. Bus Couplers and Changeover: Manual or automatic bus couplers allow selective generator-backed supply to essential loads. Automatic or manual changeover systems switch between mains and standby power. Wiring Practices Loop-Out Feeds: Distribution boxes often include loop-out feeds controlled by isolators, allowing extension of the electrical system while the main assembly remains live. Internal Wiring: Hard-wired connections inside the box should be organized to separate high-current circuits from low-voltage lighting circuits. Termini...

1000V Tunnel Power Distribution
