Connect the second router to a LAN port of the first router. Configure it in Access Point mode with a static IP in the same subnet to avoid conflicts. This setup extends Wi-Fi coverage or adds extra Ethernet ports without creating network conflicts.
- Separate Routers with Multiple Public IPs** If your ISP provides multiple public IP addresses, you can connect each router to a switch that links to the ONT. Each router receives its own public IP, allowing independent networks for different apartments or segments. This method requires proper IP allocation and may involve configuring point-to-point links and routing between routers.

Technical Considerations

- Ensure the fiber cable type (single-mode or multi-mode) matches the transceivers on your routers or switches.
- Use pre-manufactured fiber patch cables with the correct connectors (e.g., LC-LC) to avoid compatibility issues.
- Placement of routers is important for optimal coverage; the primary router should be centrally located, and the secondary router positioned where the signal is strong.
