Use appropriately sized conductors, typically 6 AWG (16 mm²) for standard home UPS systems, to handle the load safely.
4. Connect UPS Input for Charging: The UPS input should be connected to the main supply through a double-pole MCB or a suitable plug and socket. This allows the UPS battery to charge while the main power is available.
5. Safety Precautions: Always switch off the main supply before making connections. Follow local electrical codes and regulations. Ensure all connections are secure and the UPS is properly grounded. Avoid overloading the UPS; check the VA or watt rating against the total load of connected circuits.
6. Optional Automatic or Manual Changeover: Automatic UPS: Switches to battery power instantly during a blackout. Manual UPS: Requires manual switching to battery power using a changeover switch.
