Burial Depth The burial depth depends on local regulations, soil type, frost conditions, and surface activity. Typical depths range from 12-24 inches in urban areas to 24-48 inches in rural or high-traffic zones. In extreme cold climates, cables may need to be buried deeper to avoid frost penetration. A conductive marker tape is often buried above the conduit, about 12 inches below the surface, to assist in future cable location and prevent accidental damage.

- Loose tube fiber cable:** Resistant to moisture and environmental changes, ideal for conduit installations.
- Armored fiber cable:** Includes a metal protective layer to shield against rock pressure, rodents, and construction stress, suitable for direct burial or challenging environments.

- Direct burial:** The cable is buried directly in the soil, often with armored protection. This method is cost-effective but exposes the cable to soil movement and accidental excavation.
- Conduit installation:** The cable is pulled through pre-laid conduits, offering extra protection and easier future upgrades. Conduit pulling is preferred in urban or high-traffic areas.
