Simply plug the connectors into the corresponding ports or patch panels. Avoid touching the fiber end-face to prevent contamination. For outdoor or armored cables, ensure the protective layer is intact and suitable for environmental conditions like water and dust.

Best Practices Pull slowly and carefully to avoid kinks or twists. Use figure-8 loops for runs longer than 40 meters to prevent stress on the fibers. Inspect connectors and clean them before m...
