

Using fiber optic connection to connect two routers



AI Overview

You can connect two routers to a fiber optic connection by using the first router as the primary gateway and linking the second router to it, either in Access Point or LAN-to-WAN mode, to extend or segment your network.

Step 1: Understand Your Network Setup
The fiber optic line terminates at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or fiber modem, which converts optical signals into electrical signals for your router. Typically, the ONT provides a single public IP address, so connecting two routers directly to it is not recommended for residential setups, as it can cause IP conflicts. Instead, the first router should act as the primary gateway.

Step 2: Choose the Right Mode for the Second Router
Access Point (AP) Mode: Extends the existing network without creating a separate subnet. Ideal for seamless Wi-Fi coverage.
LAN-to-WAN Mode: Creates a separate network segment with its own subnet. Useful for isolating devices or managing traffic separately. Ensure the second router supports the chosen mode and operates on compatible frequency bands to avoid interference.

Step 3: Physical Connection
Use an Ethernet cable to connect the routers. For AP mode, connect a LAN port on the primary router to a LAN port on the secondary router. For LAN-to-WAN mode, connect a LAN port on the primary router to the WAN port on the secondary router. If using fiber directly between routers (for enterprise setups), ensure compatible SFP transceivers and single-mode or multi-mode fiber as required.

Step 4: Configure IP Addresses
Assign a static IP to the second router within the same subnet as the primary router if using AP mode, but outside the DHCP range to avoid conflicts. For LAN-to-WAN mode, configure the second router with a different subnet and set the default gateway to the primary router's LAN IP.

Step 5: Optimize Wi-Fi and Network Settings
