AI Overview

AI servers are specialized high-performance systems for AI workloads, while storage servers are dedicated to storing, managing, and providing access to large volumes of data.

AI servers are used for training AI models, performing real-time inference, and supporting hybrid workloads that combine both tasks. They are critical in industries like finance, healthcare, cybersecurity, and manufacturing, enabling applications such as predictive analytics, recommender systems, and generative AI .

Storage Servers Storage servers are dedicated systems designed to store, manage, and provide access to large amounts of data. Unlike AI servers, their primary focus is not computation but data reliability, scalability, and accessibility. Key features include:

- High-capacity storage drives (HDDs, SSDs, or NVMe)
- Redundant storage configurations (RAID arrays) to prevent data loss
- Network-attached storage (NAS) or storage area networks (SAN) for centralized access
- Data management software for backup, replication, and security
