Overview of Three Levels

Primary Distribution Box (Level I) Acts as the main distribution point, directly connected to the transformer, typically handling 0.4kV power. Supplies power to secondary distribution boxes rather than directly to end-use equipment.

Configuration: Includes main circuit isolation, main circuit breaker, main fuse, shunt isolation, and shunt leakage protection switch. Often equipped with copper busbars for optimal conductivity and may feature rainproof designs for outdoor use.

Secondary Distribution Box (Level II) Serves as an intermediate panel, routing power from the primary box to specific zones, buildings, or floors. **Configuration:** Main circuit general isolation, main circuit fuse and circuit breaker, shunt isolation, and shunt fuse and circuit breaker. Typically features double doors, spray-painted exterior, and rainproof tops for outdoor installation. Supports multiple branch circuits to tertiary switch boxes while maintaining hierarchical distribution.

Tertiary Distribution Box (Level III) The final junction box for electrical equipment, delivering power to individual devices or sockets. **Configuration:** Isolation and leakage protector for each connected device. Can be fixed or portable, ensuring individual circuit protection and adherence to the principle of "one machine, one switch, one leakage, one box, one lock". Must connect only to its designated equipment without bypassing levels.

Key Design Principles

Hierarchical Distribution: No electrical equipment should bypass levels; each level must branch power according to the system hierarchy.

Separate Circuits: Power and lighting circuits should be separated, with distinct branch circuits and sw...
