This allows the relay to measure impedance accurately and respond to faults within a specific zone.

Role in Relay Operation

The KD relay uses the compensator output to:

- Adjust the phase angle relationship between the primary current and induced secondary voltage.
- Ensure accurate fault detection for different combinations of phase faults.
- Provide instantaneous tripping when the measured impedance falls within the relay's set zone.

The relay may also include tapped auto-transformers (S and M taps) to fine-tune the reach and sensitivity, allowing precise control over the relay's response to system conditions.
