- Slot or Interface Number:** On HBAs or switches, the channel number may correspond to the slot or interface index, which is used in configuration and monitoring.

- World Wide Name (WWN):** Each FC port has a unique WWN, which is a permanent identifier, while the channel number is often a temporary or configurable reference used in software or switch management.
- N-Port and F-Port:** In a switched fabric, the N-Port (node port) on a host connects to an F-Port (fabric port) on a switch. The channel number may be used to reference these connections in SAN management interfaces.
- Multipathing:** When multiple paths exist between a host and storage, each path may be assigned a channel number to allow the operating system or SAN software to manage failover and load balancing.

Practical Use

Administrators use fiber channel numbers to:

- Configure zoning in SAN switches.
- Monitor and troubleshoot connectivity issues.
- Map storage LUNs to specific hosts.
- Identify which physical or logical path is active in multipath setups.
