Its diameter determines whether the fiber is single-mode (narrow core for long-distance, high-speed transmission) or multi-mode (wider core for shorter distances).Cladding: Surrounds the core with a lower refractive index to reflect light back into the core via total internal reflection, ensuring efficient signal propagation.Coating/Buffer: A protective layer, often made of polymer, that shields the fiber from physical damage and environmental factors.Armoring and Jacket: For outdoor cables, additional layers like metal armor or water-blocking gels protect ag...
