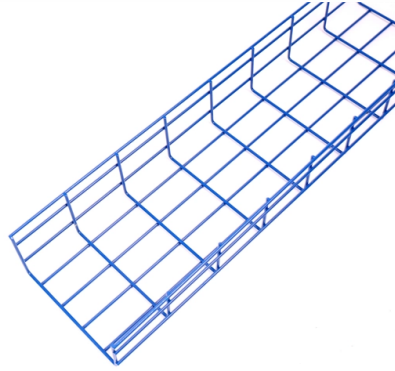

All fiber connectors include a ferrule to precisely align the fiber cores, often with a spring-loaded mechanism to ensure the fiber faces are pressed together, minimizing signal loss and reflection. Connectors are available for single-mode and multimode fibers, with polishing types such as UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) or APC (Angled Physical Contact) to match performance requirements. Choosing the right connector depends on the application, fiber type, density requirements, and environmental conditions, ensuring compatibility with patch panels, transceivers, and network equipment.
