- MPO/MTP (Multi-Fiber Push-On / Multi-Fiber Termination Push-On):** Used for high-density cabling and backbone connections rather than directly on standard SFP modules. These connectors support multiple fibers in a single interface, ideal for 40G/100G deployments.

Function and Importance

The connector ensures that light from the optical module is efficiently coupled into the fiber, reducing reflection and insertion loss. Proper connector selection is critical for network performance, as mismatched connectors require adapters and can increase operational complexity. Most connectors are spring-loaded to maintain contact pressure and precise alignment when mated.
