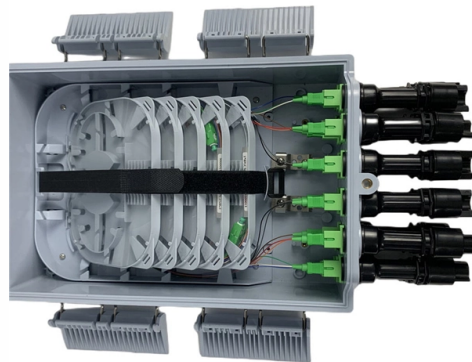


What level is an intermediate relay protection technician

- Document test results, maintenance activities, and system modifications accurately for compliance and historical records.
- Begin mentoring junior technicians or apprentices in standard procedures.
