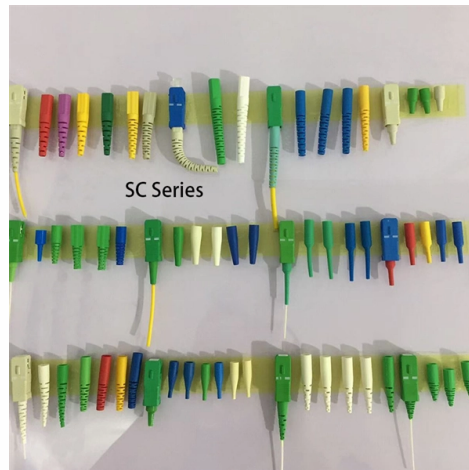

Ensure connectors click securely and are properly aligned. For patch panels, maintain consistent fiber numbering and documentation to simplify troubleshooting.

Step 5: Cable Management Route cables carefully to avoid exceeding the minimum bend radius, prevent tension, and reduce interference. Use velcro straps or cable managers to secure excess cable.
