These switches often support advanced routing protocols, multicast management, and high-speed uplinks to the core layer.

High-Availability and Redundant Aggregation Switches To ensure network resiliency, aggregation switches are frequently deployed in pairs or blocks with dual hot-swappable power supplies and redundant fans. Technologies like MCLAG or Virtual Port Channel (VPC) allow traffic to be distributed across multiple switches, providing failover capability in case of a link or device failure. This design is critical in large campus networks or multi-building deployments, where thousands of devices rely on the aggregation layer for connectivity.
