

What size router can be paired with a 100Mbps fiber optic connection

Ethernet Ports: Ensure the router has at least 4 gigabit LAN ports for wired connections to devices like desktops, gaming consoles, or smart TVs. This allows stable, high-speed connections without relying solely on Wi-Fi.

Device Capacity: For a typical household, a router that can handle 20–30 devices simultaneously is sufficient. If you have many smart home devices or frequent high-bandwidth users, a higher-capacity router may be beneficial.

Additional Features: Look for routers with Quality of Service (QoS) to prioritize traffic, robust security protocols, and easy management options. Wi-Fi 6 routers also offer better efficiency for multiple devices and improved battery life for connected devices.
