- Power on the router and check indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.
- Access the router's admin panel via a browser to configure settings and enter ISP credentials if required.
- Test the connection using network testing tools to ensure signal strength and performance are optimal.

Additional Tips

- Handle fiber carefully:** Dust, dirt, or sharp bends can degrade performance.
- Choose the correct connector type:** SC/APC, SC/UPC, or LC connectors must match your equipment.
- Maintain proper cable management:** Avoid exceeding the minimum bend radius and secure excess cable with velcro straps or cable managers.
